- drop your child/ren at the rear of the MBPAC (Town Hall) by 4:45pm on Wed 27th Nov
- collect your child/ren after the performance at the rear door (we won't let them go unless there's an adult to collect them)







Spotlight on the R/1s, including Superhero Friday


